Indian Market and Festival Guidelines

To ensure that all guests have a comfortable and safe experience, please observe the following guidelines:

- Firearms, knives, aerosol cans, explosives, mace, and other weapons are not allowed on Eiteljorg Museum property.
- Illegal or illicit substances, drugs and drug paraphernalia are not allowed on Eiteljorg Museum property.
- Bags larger than 11x15x6 inches are not permitted. Backpacks must be worn on one shoulder or on the front. Exceptions will be made for diaper bags and medical bags upon Security verification.
- While we love animals, pets are not allowed inside or outside the Eiteljorg Museum. Service dogs are welcome at Eiteljorg Museum. Emotional support, therapy, comfort, or companion animals are not considered service animals under the guidelines of the ADA and are not allowed.
- To keep artwork safe, no drinks, food, and/or chewing gum is permitted inside the galleries. Please keep beverage containers closed and inside a bag while visiting the galleries.
- The Eiteljorg Museum is a smoke, tobacco, vape-free campus.
- Eiteljorg Museum is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Additional items may be prohibited at the discretion of law enforcement or security officials.

For safety purposes, guests are subject to visual inspection of parcels, bags, and/or containers capable of concealing prohibited items. Guests may refuse inspections, however they will not be allowed into the Festival.
